Suffolk Humane Society is comprised of volunteers from all walks of life contributing their time, energy, creativity, skills, and passion for animals to the mission of the group.

Our Goal:

Our fundamental goal is to stop euthanasia as a means to control animal overpopulation, beginning in our community, Suffolk, VA. In order to do this, we must focus on the causes of the overpopulation problem. Pet owners and prospective pet owners need to recognize the responsibility they hold in the treatment and care of their pets.

Objectives To Achieve Our Goal

Spay/Neuter Programs: Sponsor community spay/neuter programs to the extent possible

Adoption Programs: Sponsor frequent adoptions; have animals available at a variety of locations for adoption.

Humane Education: Advocate the human-animal bond, respect for animals, and responsible pet ownership.

Raise funds through individual, business, and community donations, and through hosting fundraising events to directly support our mission, and to supplement the cost of services provided to the animals in the Suffolk Animal Control Bureau.

The Suffolk Humane Society is dedicated to promoting the welfare of companion animals in the community through sponsoring spay/neuter programs, increasing avenues for placing homeless animals in loving permanent homes, and providing quality humane education with an emphasis on responsible pet ownership. At this time, the Suffolk Humane Society does not operate its own animal shelter. Rather, it supports the efforts of the Suffolk Animal Control Bureau, with the core purpose to eliminate euthanasia as a means to relieve pet overpopulation.
